## WHAT TO WEAR



**JAZZ** Plain leotard with bike pants or tights. Jazz/Dance pants and crop tops can be worn. No lace ultra-flex black jazz shoes preferred. No skirts or baggy t-shirts. Danzart uniform preferred.



**TAP Wear** Plain leotard with bike pants or tights. Jazz/Dance pants and crop tops can be worn. Camel tap shoes. Danzart uniform preferred



**HIP HOP FUNK** Plain leotard with bike pants or tights. Jazz/Dance pants and crop tops can be worn. No lace ultra-flex black jazz shoes preferred. No skirts or baggy t-shirts. Danzart uniform preferred.



**CLASSICAL BALLET** Plain leotard with pink ballet tights and pink ballet shoes. Primary Ballet: Pale Pink Leotard, Grade 1 & 2 Ballet - Pale Blue Leotard, Grade 3 & 4 Ballet - Navy Blue Leotard, Grade 5 and all levels above - Black leotard. Soft classical skirt in matching colour of leotard allowed. No skirts or baggy t-shirts. Hair should be pulled back into a bun at all times. No fringes.



**ACROBATICS** Plain leotard with bike pants or comfortable shorts. No skirts or baggy t-shirts. Danzart uniform preferred.



**CREATIVE DANCE FOR UNDER 5's, TINIES AND PRE-PRIMARY CLASSES** Plain pink leotard with pink ballet tights and pink ballet shoes, soft pink classical skirt allowed.

**CONTEMPORARY** comfortable dance clothes. Eg, dance pants, dance singlets or tops. Footlets or foot thongs are preferred otherwise bare feet.

**NO JEWELRY TO BE WORN** The art of dance follows certain disciplines; this coupled with a positive reinforcement creates a high self-esteem. For the children/students to realize their full potential and enjoy their extra curricular activity the following guidelines must apply. Danzart Studio has a uniform which is available for purchase and the preferred dress code.

**HAIR:** Hair should be kept back away from face at all times, either in a ponytail or bun with hair band. Short hair should be kept tidy.

**BOYS:** All age groups for boys can wear bike shorts, dance pants, t-shirts or dance singlets. Danzart shirts preferred.

## **Danzart studio provides opportunities for students to participate in end of year concerts, public displays, dance eisteddfods and exams**

**CLASSICAL** Classical dance is taught under the RAD syllabus. Some students will be eligible to sit for these exams. RAD is one of the most recognized syllabi in the world. If students wish to sit for these exams it is compulsory to attend two classes a week. The second class commences in Term 1 and continues until the exam session is over (usually Mid July/August). A workshop has to be attended in the 2nd week of the June/July holidays. After the exam session is over some of the classical classes combine for items for the end of the year concert. The students who are sitting Major exams must attend two classes per week for the entire year.

**CSTD TAP EXAMS** These exams are held in October. Students who wish to participate in these exams are to attend a 2nd class commencing the end of Term 2. There will be a workshop in the 2nd week of the Sept/Oct holidays.

**CSTD JAZZ EXAMS** Jazz exams are beneficial for those students who do not attend classical classes and are interested in furthering themselves in this facet. These exams improve technique and give the students more polish to their jazz performances. These exams are held in October. Students who wish to participate in these exams are to attend a 2nd class commencing the end of Term 2. There will be a workshop in the 2nd week of the Sept/Oct holidays.

**COMMUNITY PERFORMANCES** At different times throughout the year Danzart is quite often asked to perform at community events throughout the year. If your school or organization wishes Danzart to perform could you please notify me as early as possible. Community performances are a no pressure, fun way of displaying the student's hard work and efforts.

**EISTEDDFODS** At the beginning of the year selected Danzart students are offered the opportunity to perform at eisteddfods. Though committing to an Eisteddfod group requires extra rehearsals (usually held on Friday afternoons) Performing at Eisteddfods allows students the opportunity to compete against other dance schools as well as witness the expanse creativity, choreography and quality of other dance Troupes. If your child is interested in Eisteddfods please let me know, even if your child's dance is not chosen as an Eisteddfod routine, they may be able to be part of another group, or even do a solo, duo or trio. Being part of an Eisteddfod Group requires commitment and dedication from both parents and students and are expected to be very disciplined and enthusiastic. They are also a lot of fun and rewarding!

**PLEASE NOTE** None of the above is compulsory and students will not be penalised in anyway if they choose not to participate in these events. Exams, Eisteddfods and Public Displays are avenues on offer for those students who wish to further themselves in the art of dance and for those who enjoy performing.

### **Fee terms and conditions**

Accounts are given at the beginning of each term.  
Accounts must be paid within 2 weeks of issue, **INCLUSIVE OF GST**.  
Unless prior arrangements are made with Miss Kellie a late fee  
Of \$25.00 may be charged on overdue accounts.

Missed lessons must be paid for.  
One off general absences will not be deducted from fees.  
Once a student has started a term, full payment for that term is required.  
No refunds will be issued if the student decides to cease class.  
If a student wishes to change their class from the original enrolment in any  
term a 'Request for Change of Class' form must be completed.  
Once a student has committed to eisteddfods, concerts, exam classes and  
other such performances there will be no refunds on fees paid if the student  
decides to withdraw from that commitment.
